On 05/06/10 at approximately 1600 hours, at 600 East Walnut Street, I made follow-up contact with the victim of this case, identified as

Ms. arrived at the police department and stated she had some questions for me. Ms. stated she had spoken with her coach at the University of Missouri regarding this incident. Ms. stated she believed her scholarship was in danger, because of her arrest. Ms. stated her coach made her feel as though she would not have any problems with her scholarship if she declined to prosecute Derrick Washington for assaulting her. Ms. stated her coach said her scholarship would be fine if the incident stayed out of the news. Ms. stated that her coach pointed out that if Mr. Washington was arrested the incident would make the news and the situation with her scholarship might change. Ms. stated she had thought about the situation, and she decided she wanted to decline prosecution on Mr. Washington.

I completed a Columbia Police Department's Decline Prosecution form for Ms. regarding Derrick Washington. I showed the form to Ms. and had her read it. Ms. stated she agreed with what the form said, and signed the bottom. I signed the form as a witness. I asked Ms. if she had any further questions, and she did not. Ms. then left the police department.
